

Welcome to our IceWorks Adult League

- A few basic things we'll need from you to start: A team name, jersey color and your desired division.
- 2) The cost to play in our Adult League is \$4,800.00. We require a \$1,500.00 deposit by your first game. You have up until your team's 10th game to pay in full. If your team is paid in full by your team's 5th game, you will receive a \$300.00 discount, bringing the cost down to \$4,500.00. We accept cash, check or credit card at our front office. There is also an online method to pay. You will receive a receipt each time you make a payment. Please keep those for your records.
- 3) Each season is 18 games, plus playoffs. Games are played Monday-Sunday. Please be prepared to play a minimum of three weekend games. We allow each team to black out two days that they cannot play (i.e. Sunday and Monday). You will not be scheduled on days that you request to block off.
- 4) Each game will consist of three 15-minute periods. NO TIE GAMES! Tie games will go to a 5-minute sudden death (3-on-3) overtime, then to a 3-man shootout to decide a victor. In the playoffs, a first overtime will be 5 minutes of 5-on-5 play. Second OT will be 5 minutes of 4-on-4. Third OT and beyond will be 5 minutes of 3-on-3 play until a goal is scored.
- 5) Absolutely NO FIGHTING! If a player is assessed a fighting major, he will be given an automatic one-game suspension by the league. A second fight will result in a 3-game suspension. A third fighting major will result in removal for the rest of the season with no refund.
- 6) We also have a zero-tolerance policy for alcohol. Please take a second to review:

 A. If any player or team is caught with alcohol on the bench or in the locker room,
 before, during or after any game, the game will result in an immediate and automatic
 forfeit regardless of the score. If an incident happens during the game, the referees,
 scorekeepers and all IceWorks employees have the authority and have been

instructed to end the game immediately, no matter how much time is remaining in the game. The offending player(s) will be banned from the building.

- B. If a second offence occurs, the team will also be removed from the league with no refund.
- C. We expect that all teams, captains and players will abide by our rules, as well as with the rules of USA Hockey.
- 7) Each team is required to file a team roster with players' first and last names, along with a jersey number. You can roster as many players as you deem necessary, including subs. Substitute players must play at least eight regular-season games to qualify for playoffs.
- 8) All players must register with USA Hockey. All players must submit their CURRENT USA Hockey Membership to their team captain. Captains will be responsible for turning in USAHockey numbers and a full team roster, including subs, to the league coordinator. No players will be allowed onto the ice without it. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!
- 9) Tiebreakers for league standings are as follows: 1) Total points 2) Total wins 3) Head-to-head results 4) Goals against 5) Goals for 6) Least penalties taken in the season. If it's a three-way tie: 1) Total points 2) Total wins 3) Goals against 4) Goals for 5) Least penalties taken.
- 10) Home teams are required to supply pucks for each game. If teams have clashing colored jerseys, the Away team must change uniforms.
